



THE 2012 SOUTHERN HICKORY FOUR-BALL CHAMPIONSHIP

I am pleased to announce that the 2012 Tad Moore Southern Hickory Four-Ball Championship – “The Woody” – will be played April 19-21 (practice round on the 19th) in Birmingham, Ala., at the beautiful Highland Park Golf Club. Highland Park was established in 1903 as the Birmingham Country Club and the first golf course in Alabama. It was the site of one of Bobby Jones’ first victories and will be a delight to play.



We are also very pleased to be the first in the six-part Championship Series of the Society of Hickory Golfers. The Series is sponsored by Mountain Valley Spring Water and we thank the company for its enthusiastic support of hickory golf.

We have secured the historic Tutwiler Hotel (a Hampton Inn and Suites property) as the host hotel. It is just 10 minutes from the course. (Details on registration page.)

Entry fee for the 2012 Southern Four-Ball is \$600 per team and includes three rounds of golf, a Thursday Night Welcome Party and trade show after the practice round, and Friday box lunch. After golf on Saturday there will be a cookout and tournament awards in the clubhouse. We’ve already had teams calling about the event, so register early. As always, if you do not have a partner, please let me know as early as possible and we will try to secure one for you.

The Woody is a two-person best-ball event that is held in both Gross and Net flights. It is very important that you and your partner have a valid hickory handicap. The Society of Hickory Golfers provides this as a free service at www.hickorygolfers.com. If you do not have a hickory handicap, your current “steel” handicap will be used for the Net competition. Society of Hickory Golfers Rules and Guidelines will be used. If you have any questions, please check with me or refer to www.hickorygolfers.com.

Directions to the Tutwiler Hotel

The Tutwiler Hotel is 5 miles from the Birmingham-Shuttlesworth International Airport. A taxi is \$12 one way and \$24 round trip. You can arrange for free airport shuttle transportation by contacting the hotel's "Make It Happen" team at 205-322-2100.

From the Airport

Go SW on Messer Airport Hwy. Take the I-20W/I59S ramp towards downtown. Take the 22nd Street exit on the left to downtown. Turn left onto 22nd Street. Go three blocks and turn right onto Park Place. The hotel is on the corner of Park Place and Richard Arrington Jr. Blvd (21st Street). Drive across Richard Arrington Drive and turn left into the hotel's driveway and porte cochere.

From I-20 West (Atlanta) or I-59 South (Gadsden/Chattanooga)

Take the 22nd Street exit on the left to downtown. Turn left onto 22nd Street. Go three blocks and turn right onto Park Place. The hotel is on the corner of Park Place and Richard Arrington Jr. Blvd (21st Street). Drive across Richard Arrington Drive and turn left into the hotel's driveway and porte cochere.

From I-20 East/I-59 North (Tuscaloosa)

Take the 22nd Street exit to downtown. Turn right onto 22nd Street. Go three blocks and turn right onto Park Place. The hotel is on the corner of Park Place and Richard Arrington Jr. Blvd (21st Street). Drive across Richard Arrington Drive and turn left into the hotel's driveway and porte cochere.

From I-65

Take I-20E/I-59N to the 22nd Street exit to downtown. Turn right onto 22nd Street. Go three blocks and turn right onto Park Place. The hotel is on the corner of Park Place and Richard Arrington Jr. Blvd (21st Street). Drive across Richard Arrington Drive and turn left into the hotel's driveway and porte cochere.

Valet Parking

The Tutwiler has no on-site parking, but its team of Ambassadors will valet your car for you during your stay. Overnight valet parking is \$17 (plus tax) for hotel guests. Call the "Make It Happen" line 15 minutes before you need your car and the staff will have it waiting for you.
