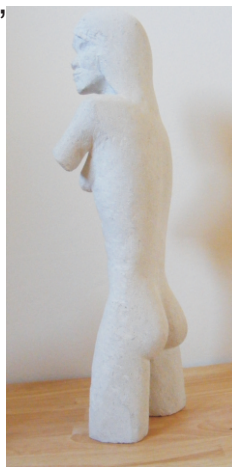
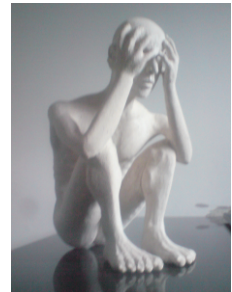
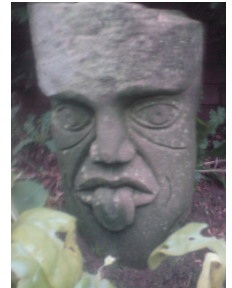

Here are the notes for install and foundation requirements.

- 1.Details of the stone sizes are on the drawing.
Base depth will be 25cm and name plate is 20cm.
- 2.Foundation depth is no less than 60cm in depth,
1metre 25cm in length and 30cm in depth which will
give a 2.5cm border all round.
- 3.Foundation will be excavated by hand perfectly to suit size
of headstone and filled with concrete.
- 4.Lifting equipment will be required to get the headstone from van
and into position. No damage to surrounding headstone's will
happen. Boards for the tracked forklift will be used to save the grass
so there will be no damage.
- 5 There will be no work required to the surrounding ground.
- 6.The headstone base will be fixed to the concrete with two stainless
steel memorial pins and the headstone will be fixed to the base 'also'
with two stainless steel pins (highlighted in yellow) on the drawing.

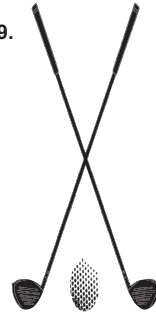
