This unique *Pre-1900*, gutty challenge will be contested at the Eagle Springs Golf Resort in Eagle, (Southern) Wisconsin. The course opened for play in 1893. As the course grew to 18 holes, it is believed that Tom Bendelow, who worked for the AG Spalding Golf Company in Chicago, was the course architect. After the depression in 1929 the golf course was cut to 9-holes. Today, approximately 90% of the historic layout remains intact.

Schedule of events:

Thursday, July 20: Registration. Practice rounds, call golf shop 262-594-2462. Pay the course directly. Need to be off the course by 5pm. As in past years, this is the time to play your alternate-shot grudge matches.

Friday, July 21: Morning tee times. Food at the course after play. Complimentary trade tables available for buying, selling, bartering or bragging.

Saturday, July 22: Morning tee times. Awards. On the road early afternoon.
