Scheduled for Sept. 17-19, the Mike Just North/South Challenge Matches are to be played on the Donald Ross-designed Hill Course in French Lick, Ind. This was the venue for both the 2011 and 2012 U.S.Hickory Opens. Walter Hagen won the 1924 PGA Championship on this course.

Sponsored by the Society of Hickory Golfers, in conjunction with the centennial celebration of the Hill Course, the North/South Challenge Match is to be a Ryder Cup-style format with a maximum of two 32-person teams (64 players total) of players from North and South regional hickory groups.

Organizer Chris Deinlein says the event is designed to serve as a memorial tournament in honor of Mike Just, who passed away in October 2016.

"Mike played high school and college matches on this course," Deinlein says. "The Resort's golf representatives are thrilled to have the Society return for these matches and equally honored to host the Mike Just Memorial."

The format calls for practice rounds on Sunday followed by Monday foursomes in the morning and an afternoon of fourball matches. Tuesday will bring singles matches with a shotgun start. A Sunday night cocktail reception is planned as is an awards lunch.

Rates at the French Lick Resort hotel have been negotiated at \$159 per night. Call the hotel directly at 812-936-9300 and mention the code 0917HSO to get the negotiaged rate.

The North/South Challenge Match is the second tournament sponsored by the SoHG, the U.S. Hickory Open being the Society's primary tournament emphasis.

The North/South Challenge Matches and Mike Just Memorial are a special one-time tournament timed to coordinate with French Lick Resort's 2017 centennial celebrations. Deinlein says the tournament may be repeated in future years depending upon participant interest.
