Welcome to the California Hickory "North-South". This event is a **two-day hickory golf** tournament held on the 1932 Chandler Egan designed Pacific Grove Golf Links. Pacific Grove Golf Links is known as the "poor man's Pebble Beach" and for good reason. The course is on the north-western tip of the Monterey Peninsula about 5 miles from Pebble Beach. Pacific Ocean and Monterey Bay views are visible from almost every hole on the course, with the back 9 situated right along the coast in links style. A par 70 from just over 5,700 yards, this course is great for hickory play, and very walkable. Expect some attention from sight seers and passersby along Ocean View Blvd. Oh, and while most of the country is in roasting in the summer heat, the average day time high temperature at tournament time is a nice 66 degrees!

\*\* Friday Practice Rounds – We have 4 tee times set aside for Friday practice round if interested (spots for 16 golfers). These will likely be around the 11am hour. Please let me know if you would like to be added to the list for practice. (other times are available through the course if you plan to play at a different time. Practice rounds are NOT included with tournament entry).

## Format-

For the **first round** (Saturday June 23), all players will be split into two teams; North team, or South team. Each player will play their own ball from tee to green, holing out their own ball is a must, no matter the score. The better score of the two-man team will count against their opponents in Match Play format. After the round, either the North or South team will be crowned champions. The individual score will be added to second round score. (1st tee time at 8:00 am) TRUNK TRADE SHOW will take place again after the 1st round. Let's all try to plan on parking in the same area near the practice putting green & north-east corner (near green) for the trunk trade show.

Saturday Night (5ish) – Social get-together at the Surano's Pacific Grove home (about 1 mile from course). Address, time, direction details will be sent by email/phone closer to tournament time.

The **second round** (Sunday June 24) will be individual stroke play. The scores from round one will be added to the score from round two for a two-day total score. Prizes for Open and Net play. (1st tee times for 2nd round at 8:00 am)

After each round we will gather at the course's Point Pinos Grill for drinks/lunch at own cost (as this is popular each year). Awards/prizes/giveaways after each round at lunch.

• The Monterey Peninsula is one of the most beautiful places in our country. It is a great place to arrive early or stay late for a small vacation. There are many attractions and sites to see for you, and or spouse before, during, or after golf.
