18-hole Two Person Scramble (Registration Deadline August 7)

- \$50 per individual. \$100 per team. Includes golf with cart, lunch and prizes.
- **Schedule**
 - Friday, August 4 (*reduced rate practice round for those interested*)
 - Saturday, August 15
 - 10 -11:30 AM Swap meet. Demo for those wishing to hit a hickory club.
 - 12:00 PM Lunch
 - 1:00 PM Shotgun start
 - 5:00 PM Awards
- **Handicaps**
 - Team handicaps will be determined according to the following recommendation by the USGA for a two-person Scramble.
 - Golfer A (lowest handicap) receives 35% of their handicap
 - Golfer B (higher handicap) receives 15% of their handicap
 - Team handicap determined by adding the two together.
 - Example: Golfer A handicap 8, golfer B handicap 21. 35 percent of 8 = 2.8; 15 percent of 21 = 3.15. Adding the two = 5.9 which rounds up to 6, their team's handicap.
 - For those who play modern clubs without a hickory handicap their modern handicap will be adjusted following a modified version of the recommendation by the British Golf Collectors Society.
 - 0-3 add 2 shots
 - 4-8 add 3 shots
 - 9-14 add 4 shots
 - 15-20 add 5 shots
 - 21 + add 6 shots
 - *Determining handicaps seems always a difficult situation, especially adjusting modern to hickory. Although this is a competition it is the hope of the tournament committee the competition be taken in the spirit of friendly play, recognizing there may be a slight discrepancy in determining those handicaps for new hickory players. In addition to honoring Mike Fatke, a goal of this tournament is to welcome those new to hickory golf.*
- **Miscellaneous Information**
 - Participants form their own twosome. However, if signing up individually every attempt will be made for paring.
 - Practice - Range is located at the far end of the course along 12th Street. Balls may be obtained from the Golf Shop. One can take a cart to the range or drive your automobile south along Cherry then turn west on 12th. There is also a

short course there. A chipping area is also available west of the 18th green.

- Range finders and other distance devices will be permissible during the competition.
- Vintage dress for golf is encouraged. However, casual golf attire acceptable.
