

Mike & Elmore Foursomes Competition, practice time, lunches, dinner, refreshments, prizes and other stuff

- Competitors may order balls on the entry form. Consult the Championship Committee for a list of approved ball types
 - Appropriate dress is required (outlined on the accompanying page labeled Dress Code)
 - Divisions of competition include Open (scratch), Reserve (net), Women (net), Sporting (net)
- The International Feathery Challenge (IFC) is a separate fee event open to NHC golfers or those playing only the IBC
- "Mike & Elmore Foursomes Competition" is a separate event with prizes, which precedes the start of the Championship
 The Championship dinner is planned for Friday night at the Riverbend banquet hall, Miamisburg,
 - with spouses, friends and families <u>welcome</u>. Foursomes prizes and awards presentations following dinner
 - Entry confirmation is subject to the approval of the NHC Championship Committee which shall determine eligibility as well as decide all questions regarding the rules
 - Official NHC rule books are supplied to all golfers in arrival packets
 - First-time players <u>must</u> supply hcp information from their home club, assn., or from Society of Hickory Golfers
 - Confirmation of entry acceptance will be communicated within 30 days of entry receipt

is an open championship comprised of two days' play. It was the first competition to truly replicate gutty golf of the 19th century and serves as America's national championship of wood shafted golf.
