# July 16-18, 2020 Eagle Springs Golf Resort Eagle, Wisconsin

This unique *pre-1900*, gutty challenge is contested at the Eagle Springs Golf Resort in Eagle, (Southern) Wisconsin, which opened for play in 1893. As the course grew to 18 holes, it is believed that Tom Bendelow, who worked for the AG Spalding Golf Company in Chicago, was the course architect. After the 1929 depression, the golf course was reduced to 9 holes, of which 90% of the historic layout remains intact.

#### Schedule of events:

Thursday, July 16: Registration. Practice rounds, call golf shop 262-594-2462. Pay the course directly. Need to be off the course by 4:30pm (leagues). Today highlights the annual gutty grudge matches.

Friday, July 17: Morning shot gun. Lunch at the course. Complimentary trade tables for buying, selling, bartering or bragging. Many will meet for dinner for a traditional fish fry or BBQ at a site TBD.

Saturday, July 18: Morning shot gun. Snacks and awards in the clubhouse. On the road early afternoon.

The Democratic National Convention is held in Milwaukee, July 13-16. Hotels & private homes are booked several days or weeks prior to and/or after the official dates.

Hotels are booked as far south as Chicago, throughout the entire Milwaukee & Suburb regions, and as far north as Kohler. Accommodations are either sold out, are "dives", or offer limited availability at peak "catastrophic" rates. Our research shows that the available rate if approximately quadruple.

Our committee researched all possibilities and has been successful in booking several group rooms in Whitewater, which is only a 30-minute drive (BTW our normal location is 45 minutes away in Brookfield).
