Remote players:

Schedule your 36 holes at your convenience (or that of your course) any time over the same three dates understanding that the gang down under is already a half day ahead of US Eastern Time. Scan cards or report scores via text or email after each round. An updated scoresheet will be emailed to remote competitors after the first round.

Remember the format from last year. Design your course to match the 9-hole yardages from Oakhurst. Put them in an order that makes sense to the course you choose to play. You may

play a nine-hole course twice per day or an 18-hole course once a day.

All clubs must be wood shaft. Wherever possible use smooth face irons and splice head woods. McIntyre balls are required.

No wooden peg tees, only mounds of sand, PLEASE.

Appropriate period attire is required (we're Pandemic-liberal, could be 1890s style or 1920s style). Photos of group and/or individuals required for the program book. Well displayed. Group photos from each remote site will be prominently displayed.

Both groups will get identical tee gifts – an apparel item (surprise) and some other golffy trinkets. The post event program book, like last year's will accompany items mailed to you. Everyone's photo will be in it so please send a head shot or a portrait of you in historical golf attire if practical. In a pinch any photo will do. Mound players get their registration packets on site.

When filling out your entry form please indicate handicap if playing in the reserve or women's divisions and your shirt size. (Ladies will get lady sized garments).

Owing to the continually changing situation here and abroad, we're a little behind so please indicate your intention to play as soon as practical. We need to plan purchases/sizes accordingly.

Entry forms are attached for both on site play and remote participation. Newsletter #2 for 2021 will be emailed shortly with list of area hotels near the Mound. Future Newsletters will also provide ongoing information for players in both groups.
