

It appears that Mr. Ross and his golf courses – Mimosa Hills in North Carolina, and the Donald Ross Course at the French Lick Resort in Indiana – bring out the best in our players. # From Seaview Golf Club/Troon Golf: Players.

On behalf of the entire staff, we would like to welcome all of you to the historic Stockton Seaview Hotel & Golf Club in Galloway, N.J. It is our pleasure to host the 2013 U.S. Hickory Open and this year's event will add to the long golfing tradition that Seaview is known for, which has seen past champions such as Juli Inkster, Betsy King, Annika Sorenstam, Ai Miyazato, Karrie Webb, and Brittany Lincicome. The Bay course was also host to the 1942 PGA Championship where Sam Snead won his first major championship.

Seaview's Bay Course is an ageless classic that opened in 1914 and is a textbook Donald Ross seaside course, running along Reed's Bay. Hugh Wilson of Merion fame also assisted Ross in the design of this historical course. Their design and vision was to let the elements test the player. The

course features classic mounding, high faced bunkers, plus small greens with subtle undulations. Tall fescue grasses guard many of the bunkers and the Bay course is dramatically affected by the severity of the winds rolling off of the bay and the Atlantic Ocean. One of the greatest nuances of the course is the view of Reeds Bay and the skyline of Atlantic City from various locations on the course.

From the entire staff here at Seaview we wish you the best of luck in this year's tournament. Play well.

# The Course

A regular stop for the LPGA, the Bay Course has Donald Ross and Hugh Wilson (Merion GC) in its pedigree.



The Bay Course, on the coast of Reeds Bay at Dolce Seaview Resort in Absecon, N.J., near Atlantic City, was partially designed in 1914 by Hugh Wilson (who also designed the two courses at Merion Golf Club). The golf club itself dates from 1914, when public utility magnate Clarence H. Geist founded the Seaview Country Club. The Bay Course opened in 1915 and was completed a year later by Donald Ross who added sand bunkers.

The Seaview Country Club hosted the 1942 PGA Championship, then a match play event. Sam Snead won the final match, 2 & 1, over Jim Turnesa to claim the first of his seven major championships. He closed out the match by holing a 60-foot chip shot for birdie on the 35th hole.

A composite course was used for the event, using the front nine of the Bay Course coupled with nine holes designed by William Flynn, that later formed the Pines Course (along with the final nine holes in 1957 by William Gordon).

The links-style Bay Course (par 71, 6,247 yards from the back) features small, subtle greens with classic mounding and deepfaced bunkers. In 1997, Robert Cupp led a \$1 million restoration to bring it back to its original design. The Bay Course is a regular stop for the Ladies Professional Golf Asso-



ciation Tour - ShopRite LPGA Classic.

The Marriott Corporation bought the club in 1984 and made it a public resort. It was sold to LaSalle Hotel Properties in 1998, but Mariott continued to manage it until 2009 when Dolce Hotels and Resorts took over management of the hotel and Troon Golf was retained to manage the golf courses.

In 2009, Seaview was honored by *Golfweek* magazine as one of the "Best Courses You Can Play" in New Jersey, and by *Golf World* magazine with a 2009 Readers' Choice Award.
