



2024 USHO Information

Competition Categories

There are four divisions of competition:

Championship Seniors (60-69) Super Seniors (70+) Ladies

The Open Division will be played at 6,090-6,255 yards (5,569-5,720 meters). The Senior tees will be 5,680-5,740 (5,194-5,249 meters); Super Seniors at 5,070-5,100 (4,636-4,663 meters), and Ladies at 4,850 (4,435 meters). All flights automatically receive scores for both gross and net. Winner of the Open Division will be declared the winner of the U.S. Hickory Open. See the full rules on the USHO page of the SoHG website.

Handicaps

The USHO handicap committee reserves the right to confirm all handicaps as well as make adjustments to handicaps during the tournament as may be necessary. All player handicaps for the USHO are adjusted based on the slope and rating of the course played. Thus, your posted tournament handicap for the 2024 USHO may be slightly higher or lower than the handicap index shown on the SoHG website.


It is the responsibility of each SoHG participant in the USHO to ensure that he or she has at least five verifiable rounds within the past six months – no later than one month in advance of the USHO – posted to the handicap page of the SoHG website. Any participant with fewer than five verifiable rounds will be entered with a 0 handicap. All decisions of the tournament handicap committee shall be final.

Equipment Compliance

It is the responsibility of each applicant to ensure that his/her equipment complies with the SoHG equipment guidelines. Penalty is disqualification. 
Host Hotel – The Stella Hotel

The Stella Hotel in downtown Kenosha is a historic renovation built in the early 1900s, that was home to the Heritage House Inn and The Kenosha Elks Club. Donald Ross stayed here when he was working on the course layout at Kenosha Country Club. The hotel is close to Lake Michigan and offers contemporary rooms as well as retro one-bedroom Heritage Suites with rustic furnishings and vintage-style decor. Other amenities include three onsite restaurants, a fitness center, business center, gift and sundry shop, and a rec room. The hotel is about 6 miles from Kenosha Country Club, less than 15 minutes away.


Our room rate has been set at \$149 per night. with 75 rooms blocked for SoHG members. Click here for a direct link to the Stella Hotel for SoHG members.
